#### **ORDINANCE NO. 9 of 2025**

# AN ORDINANCE AMENDMENT TO ORDINANCE 7 OF 2024 WHICH PROVIDES THE RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR THE SUBDIVISION OF LAND IN SABINE PARISH, LOUISIANA

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Police Jury of Sabine Parish, Louisiana in regular and legal session convened, a quorum being present and voting, that the following change is made to Ordinance 7 of 2024:

SECTION IV – GENERAL REQUIREMENTS is amended to add Section IV E. (1) with it to read as follows:

SECTION IV - GENERAL REQUIREMENTS

#### E. Permits

(1) No electric utility company licensed to do or doing business in the Parish of Sabine shall install or connect service to any mobile home or RV until a Final Sewer and Building permit have been issued. No electric utility company licensed to do or doing business in the Parish of Sabine shall install or connect temporary service, nor install or connect permanent service, to any residential, commercial or any other structure until the Final Sewer and Building Permits have been issued.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that this ordinance shall be in effect September 17, 2025, and it shall be published one time in the Official Journal of the Parish of Sabine, State of Louisiana, along with any other minutes of the meeting.

The foregoing ordinance having been offered upon a motion by Taylor and seconded by Garcie was then submitted to an official vote and the vote thereupon was recorded as follows to wit:
