Approve Change Order No. 2 for the Landfill Gas Collection and Control System Installation Mr. Juene Franklin, with Franklin Engineers and Consultants, L.L.C., has recommended approval of a change order, Change Order No. 2, to modify and connect the leachate clean-out risers in five locations. The change order will increase the cost of the project by \$49,100.00 and add five calendar days to the substantial completion date. Upon approval of Change Order No. 2, the substantial completion date will be March 4, 2024, and the adjusted contract cost will be \$2,000,183.25.

The change order will increase the cost of the project by \$2,618.40 and add one calendar day to the substantial completion date. Upon approval of Change Order No. 3, the substantial completion date will be March 5, 2024 and the adjusted contract cost will be \$2,002,801.65.
