

Solid Waste Meeting  
January 26, 2022 at 10 AM

On January 26, 2022, at 10 am, the Solid Waste Committee of the Sabine Parish Police Jury met in the Sabine Parish Police Jury boardroom at 400 S. Capitol St., Room 101, in Many, Louisiana.

The committee members present were Mr. Ricky "K-Wall" Sepulvado, Mr. Mike McCormic, and Mr. Stephen Steinke, along with Mr. Bill Weatherford, Secretary-Treasurer, Mr. Pete Chreene, Landfill Supervisor, and Ms. Lindy Strahan, Administrative Assistant. Mr. Kenneth Ebarb was absent.

Mr. Sepulvado called the meeting to order. Mr. Weatherford called roll. A quorum was present. Mr. Weatherford led the meeting with prayer. Mr. Steinke led the meeting with pledge of allegiance.

There were no amendments to the agenda. On a motion by Mr. Steinke, second by Mr. McCormic, with all in favor, the agenda was adopted.

After a lengthy discussion, a motion by Mr. McCormic, a second by Mr. Steinke, with all in favor, the scale house worker will be moved to the office and hire a person for the scale house. The new employee's pay for scale house will be \$14.00 per hour.

On a motion by Mr. McCormic, a second by Mr. Steinke, with all in favor, Mr. Chreene can hire an additional operator at the pay rate of \$23 per hour.

On a motion by Mr. Steinke, a second by Mr. McCormic, with all in favor, the pay rate for the office secretary will be \$15.50 per hour.
